

## **AUTHORIZED JOB PERFORMANCE TEST PROCTOR POLICY**

The Fluid Power Certification Board (FPCB) recognizes “Authorized Job Performance Test Proctors” for the purpose of test set-up, proctoring, and grading of the test as required by the FPCB for Mechanic and Technician Certification. Only authorized proctors are permitted to conduct this required portion of the Mechanic and Technician Certification tests. This is necessary to promote consistency and uniformity at all test offerings.

“Authorized Job Performance Test Proctors” recognized by the Fluid Power Certification Board have obtained at least one certification (Mechanic or Technician), and completed a required 1 day workshop dealing with the administration and grading of the test.

In summary, the requirements for becoming an “Authorized Job Performance Test Proctor” are:

- Make application for Job Performance Training Workshop.
- Review session approval by FPCB
- Have Mechanic or Technician Certification
- Keep IFPS membership and Certification current.
