What you need to know about a JPTW ...

What is expected of you?

Only IFPS “Authorized Job Performance Test Proctors” are authorized to conduct JP tests for Mechanic and Technician Certification. IFPS policies and the “Instructor Agreement” govern the relationship with “Authorized Job Performance Test Proctors”.

The workshop is a one-day effort to acquaint you with the certification program and the manual provided for Job Performance review training and test proctoring. It is not a program to teach how to be an instructor but rather to acquaint you with the structure of the manual and the grading of tests. It also is intended to acquaint you with the IFPS, how the overall Certification program works and where you go to get answers.

You must fill out an application (forms attached):

- Job Performance review training and proctoring

Sometime during the JPTW session you will be required to grade a job performance test. You will be graded on your ability to grade the test properly.

Granting of IFPS accreditations is by the Fluid Power Certification Board, based on the 1) application information, 2) The facilitator’s recommendation.
