Instructions for Test Candidates

For Hydraulic Specialist Certification

Please read and follow these instructions carefully, and do not open your Test Booklet or begin working until the proctor grants permission.

You have a total of three (3) hours to complete this test. The total points contained in the test is 50. A total of 35 points are required for a passing score.

No individual taking the test will be permitted to continue beyond the allotted time of three (3) hours.

Permission to leave the room during the test must be obtained from the test proctor.

Misconduct of any kind during the test will automatically disqualify an individual.

Testing Guidelines

1. Please check your packet for the following items:
 - ID/Instruction Sheet
 - Answer Key
 - Test Booklet
2. Prior to starting the test, write your name, the proctor's name, the test location and password on this ID Sheet. The password may be used to retrieve your score from the IFPS web site (www.IFPS.org). Please read and complete the information thoroughly. Also, please print your name clearly as it will be used to complete your Certificate.

3. Using a #2 pencil, write your Last Name, First Name **and Identification #** (Social Security Number with no spaces) on the Answer Key. Blacken the corresponding circles under the letters and numbers you write.
4. When answering the test questions, fill in the circles on the Answer Key with heavy black marks using a #2 pencil only. Please note the following:
 - **Only one answer will be the most correct for each question.** You may notice a slight deviation between your answer and the test answer due to rounding.
 - **Mark only one answer on the Answer Key.** Make sure changed answers are completely erased. Partial marks can be mistaken for a second answer.
 - **If more than one answer is marked,** it will be graded wrong.
 - **Scratch paper is not permitted.** You may write in your Test Booklet to calculate the solution to the question.
5. You may use any soft or hard **bound, copyrighted fluid power technical reference books.** No other books, loose notes that are typed or hand-written, or writing pads will be permitted. **The Manual/Study Guide issued by the International Fluid Power Society is not permitted.** Hand-held, non-programmable, silent calculators with no word-processing ability are allowed.
6. Discussion or exchange of any information and sharing of reference materials, calculators, etc. among individuals is not permitted during the test.
7. The proctor **will not** answer technical questions concerning any of the test items, but will answer questions about the testing procedure.
8. When you have completed your test, or the three (3) hour time period has expired, please turn in your Test Booklet, Answer Key and this ID Sheet to the proctor (if your test was in a envelope, please place it back in the envelope before turning it in to the proctor).

Attention NICET Candidates: The proctor's verbal instructions will be for the NICET examinees. The instructions above are for you, an IFPS Certification Candidate, and must be read thoroughly. General test instructions, such as the command to start/finish the test and restroom visits will apply to you as well as the NICET examinees.
